2025-26 Senior High Basketball State Final Four Information Guide

Congratulations on earning a trip to this year's OCSAA State Final Four weekend. The OCSAA Senior High State Final Four will be held on Friday & Saturday March 13-14 at Ohio Christian University located at: 1476 Lancaster Pike, Circleville, Ohio 43113. The games will be played in the Maxwell Center which is located at the back of the OCU campus. The First Baptist (girls), Ohio Valley (girls), High Street (boys) and Chess (boys) will be considered the **Home** teams on Friday and will wear their home (white) uniforms. The Ross County (girls), Mentor (girls), Hearts (boys) and Liberty Bible (boys) will be considered the **Away** teams and will wear their away (dark) uniforms. Follow the schedule of games below to see who the home and away teams are on Saturday.

The OCSAA will provide the game officials, warm-up balls, game balls, the Official Scorebook, Final Four Programs, coolers with water and cups, plus gate and concession help for the State Final Four. The Participating schools should arrive on time with all players, coaches, team staff, **team TRAINER (ice bags will be available for injuries but no Trainer on site)**, uniforms and game gear present, and ready to go. Note that posted game times are approximates and all games will start 30 minutes after the previous game and award ceremony has ended. Please have your "School Pass Form" filled out and ready to hand in (do not email it to the OCSAA). Only **TEAM** personnel listed on the "School Pass Form" will be admitted without payment. **Do not bring your own warm-up balls!** You will find copies of all the necessary forms and letters on the OCSAA website. You will also find information about Ohio Christian University and area hotels on the OCSAA website. Most hotels will give teams playing at OCU a discounted rate...be sure to mention that when making reservations.

Girl's Third Place Game:	11:00 AM – Game 1 loser (H) vs Game 2 loser (A)
Boy's Third Place Game:	1:00 PM – Game 3 loser (H) vs Game 4 loser (A)
Girl's Championship Game:	3:00 PM – Game 1 winner (H) vs Game 2 winner (A)
Boy's Championship Game:	5:00 PM – Game 3 winner (H) vs Game 4 winner (A)

NOTE: Game times are approximates, all games will start 30 minutes after the previous game and award ceremony has ended. Please let your fans know this beforehand.

There will be an awards ceremony immediately following each Saturday game. Parents and fans will be permitted on the gym floor after the award ceremony to take team and individual player pictures. Admission prices are as follows (includes all four games played that day).

If you are heard making remarks as mentioned above, you will be asked to leave the gymnasium and will not be allowed back for any other games over the weekend and will not be refunded any gate fees. Please feel free to dress in your school's colors, paint your faces and cheer your team on to victory. Keep in mind NOISEMAKERS are not allowed and anyone with signs, banners or posters must keep them in the bleachers, you are not allowed on the floor with sings, banners and posters. Fans are not allowed to stand on the gym floor or against the gym walls during play. You must be in the stands while the game is in play unless you are going to the restroom or concession area.
